### 2.01 BIRTHS AND DEATHS

The total number of brands in circulation increased by 113 brands overall and 112 in handmades. A total of 223 brands (211 handmades) entered (or re-entered) national distribution since the last edition, compared with 55 brands (64 handmades) last year. Of the 211 new handmades, six returned to the market in 2009 (marked by ■) after being out of national distribution in recent years. The new entries:

### 2.02 BRAND FACTS

Here are some entertaining facts about cigar brands and where they are produced:

#### *Ancient brands:*

---

Some brands have been with us since the early part of the 19th Century, originating primarily in Cuba. Some of the older brand names still being produced (or at least, available) for the U.S. market, with their original country of origin, include:

### *Bands on brands:*

It is well established that in 1850, Gustave Bock of the Netherlands put bands on cigars for the first time, as a method of distinguishing his firm's Cuban-made cigars.

### *Brand production:*

The Dominican Republic remains the top producer of U.S.-marketed cigars. In this edition, 38.2% of all brands were produced there, down from 39.4% last year. Among handmades, the Dominican accounted for 41.4%, down from 42.8% in the 2009 edition.

Nicaragua has been on the rise as a brand producer and moved into second place as a brand producer for the first time ever in our listings, with 305½ handmade brands (23.1%, up from 20.9%), just edging Honduras (303½ for 23.0%, up from 22.5%), the perennial silver medalist.

The U.S. (including Puerto Rico) remained fourth with 7.1% of handmades (same as last year), but with 13.3% of all cigars (same as last year). No other country accounted for as much as 1% of the total number of handmades or brands on the market.

*(Readers of the following table should note that in classifying the origin of each brand, fractional attributions were made for cigars that are produced in more than one country.)*
